First Announcement

The Institute of Oceanography (VNIO) established on 14th September 1922 at Nha Trang city, Khanh Hoa Province is considered as the national marine research institution of Vietnam, which has been responsible for studies not only on oceanography but also on marine resources and environment as well as for postgraduate training on marine science.

During last nearly 90 years, scientists of VNIO and other domestic/international institutions have conducted series of researches, achieving significant understanding on oceanographic processes and marine resources and environment of Bien Dong (East Sea), contributing to marine resource sustainable uses, nature conservation and environment management of the country.

The first Sientific Conferences on Bien Dong was organized in 2000, followed by the second in 2002, and the third in 2007 (on the occasion of the 80th and 85th Anniversary of VNIO respectively). The International Conference on Bien Dong 2012 as an event to celebrate the 90th Anniversary of VNIO will be a time for looking back scientific activities in the Vietnamese and adjacent waters and a chance for orientation of activities in the future with wide participation of Vietnamese and foreign scientists, managers and policy makers.
